Introduction

This is a journal that is designed to bring you into a greater intimacy with the Lord by becoming better acquainted with His Spirit. In particular the *fruit* of the Spirit. The apostle Paul reveals characteristics of the Holy Spirit in Galatians 5, calling them the fruit of the Spirit. We normally focus on our desire to extend this fruit towards others. However, I suggest in order for us to offer this fruit to others, we must first see this fruit in the Lord so we may properly recognize what it really is, and *Who* He really is. We must breathe in His Spirit before we can breathe out, just as we must plant seed before the fruit will grow. As we see the mature fruit in the Lord, we will properly recognize it in our life as it grows, ensuring we are cultivating the right seed.

These nine characteristics of the Holy Spirit reveal the heart and nature of our Jesus and our Heavenly Father. When we see this fruit in Him and plant these seeds into our life through the Holy Spirit, we will be able to produce fruit the way He intends. Not out of a sense of duty or obligation, but because they've grown from our new nature in Christ. I pray this journal helps you to know the Lord more intimately and that you receive His Holy Spirit to the fullest measure possible in Christ.

But the fruit of the Spirit is

Galatians 5:22-23

Instructions

There are three days to each fruit of the Spirit. On the first day, study the fruit in the life of Jesus as you read and meditate on the Scripture for the day. Envision this fruit as a part of God's very nature. It is, after all, the fruit of the **Holy Spirit**—God's own characteristics. As you see the maturity of the fruit in Him, it will help you to identify it properly.

On the second day, receive the seed of His fruit to be planted in you. It's like you're harvesting the seed from the fruit you've partaken of from Him. It comes through His Word. It's planted in you through His Word. Receive His Seed/Words and make a decision to nurture them and allow them to flourish in you.

Matthew 13:1-23.

Finally, on the third day, consider how this fruit not only benefits you, but others. Envision the seed growing into a plant and a place of maturity where you now offer the fruit of it to others around you. This happens, not because you force yourself to behave a certain way, but simply because it has become your nature. It's who you are now--a born-again believer in Jesus Christ, one filled with the breath of His Holy Spirit, abiding in Jesus, and therefore producing good fruit.

Be sure to read each Scripture for the day slowly. Take a minute to meditate on it so you fully absorb what the Lord is speaking to you each day. There are suggestions at the bottom of each page if you want to use those phrases to ponder on throughout the day. Write out your thoughts in the space provided.

Your Fruit of Joy

Hebrews 12:2

fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Jesus, joy strengthened You. You saw the outcome, the prize, the goal, and the joy of what You saw gave you the determination to do Your part in fulfilling the Father's plan. This kind of joy is not a shallow happiness that denies the seriousness of a situation, but a deep, internal fire that ignites a determined hope. It energizes, and it is prophetic. It sees into the future. It believes that things will work out as the Father desires. Your joy made eternal life available to me!

Read the Scripture above slowly, word for word, several times. Envision the joy of the Holy Spirit strengthening Jesus so He could endure what He did. Don't think about yourself right now, just Jesus, and how this joy looked in Him.

John 15:11

These things I have spoken to you so that My joy may be in you, and *that* your joy may be made full.

Lord, I will nurture Your joy in me. I harvest the seeds from Your fruit and plant them within me. They are planted in me through what You've spoken—through Your words. Your words are spirit and life. John 6:63 Your words are seeds that I will cultivate. Your words bring joy to me. This joy has brought me to Your salvation. It has brought me into eternal life. I never want to lose the joy of Your salvation! I never want to take it for granted. Your joy enabled You to endure much and overcome so You could fulfil the Father's will. I receive and cultivate Your seeds of joy and allow them to grow strong in me, so I too can fulfil His will for me. Your joy gives me clear vision and determination so no matter what the situation, I abide in You.

Your Fruit of Peace

Luke 4:28-30

And all *the people* in the synagogue were filled with rage as they heard these things; and they got up and drove Him out of the city, and led Him to the brow of the hill on which their city had been built, in order to throw Him down the cliff. But passing through their midst, He went His way.

Jesus, they took You right to the brow of the hill on which their city had been built. They wanted to throw You off—off their foundation. There was no place for You in their doctrine. They were full of rage, but You simply passed through their midst and went Your way. This is Your way—the way of the Father’s will—no matter what people around You tried to do to You. Your peace is powerful. This peace enabled You to walk away from this crowd trying to kill You. This peace remained calm in the middle of a storm. Mark 4:35-41. It is not dependent on circumstances. It doesn’t care if everyone likes You or agrees with You. You have the Father’s love which is enough. You knew His timing. This same peace enabled You to willingly give up Your life for all when it was time. This kind of peace reveals Your faith in the Father, and it comforts me.

John 14:27

Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to You; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.

Lord, I will nurture Your peace in me. I harvest the seeds from Your fruit and plant them within me. You have given me Your peace-seeds. You've calmed the storms in my life. This is not a worldly peace that is dependent on circumstances to be favorable. It's rooted in faith in the Father. I'm aware of His power which can keep me safe from all harm. Producing Peace

John 16:33

These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world.”

Jesus, I want Your peace to grow in me in such a way that others can partake of the fruit of Your peace. So their hearts can be calmed in the midst of storms. So they realize their peace is not dependent on what goes on around them, but on remaining in You. I pray Your peace radiates from me, changing the atmosphere around me. As I speak Your words to others, that Your words reassure them that nothing is too big for You. Their life does not worry You. They too can receive Your peace and remain calm, feeling secure in any troubling situation of life—whether it’s theirs or those around them. Seeds of Goodness

Matthew 5:43-48

“You have heard that it was said, ‘YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR and hate your enemy.’ But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven; for He causes His sun to rise on *the* evil and *the* good, and sends rain on *the* righteous and *the* unrighteous. For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? If you greet only your brothers, what more are you doing *than others*? Do not even the Gentiles do the same? Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

Holy Father, I will nurture Your goodness in me. I harvest the seeds from Your fruit and plant them within me. You are perfect in every way and I follow after You. My desire is to be like You. Your goodness is a shelter for me. It is a safe place, a protected place. It is a place of Your glory. By Your goodness, I overcome the evil that would come against me, and the evil that would try to spring up within me. Your light eradicates it. I run to You when evil would try and overtake me. I run to Your light, Your holiness. Fill me with Your goodness and light and holiness! Because You are good, I’m hidden in You and kept in the secret place of Your presence. I’m safe in Your secret place. Your light purifies me, forgives me, heals, delivers, restores, and blesses. Light overcomes the darkness and good overcomes evil.

When seeds of goodness take root in me—

There is no goodness apart from You.

Yet You share Your holiness and purity with me.

When I receive Your goodness, I feel safe.

Mark 10:1

Getting up, He went from there to the region of Judea and beyond the Jordan; crowds gathered around Him again, and, according to His custom, He once more *began* to teach them.

Lord, You spent much time teaching the people while You were here on earth. You went from city to city, again and again to teach the people Your truth. Your disciples didn't understand many things until You were risen from the dead, but You kept on telling them and teaching them. You kept on illuminating them, continuously shining as a light through Your Word. Some people never understood, and they brought You to the cross. Some people will not listen to You or choose to believe. Yet You gave them a chance. You taught them and You remained in the character of the Spirit until the end. Seeds of Patience

2 Peter 3:9

The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance.

Lord, I will nurture Your patience in me. I harvest the seeds from Your fruit and plant them within me. I will do this by responding to You with attentiveness, with an open heart, and with repentance if necessary. Your patience feels the pain of sin and rejection of You. It feels the heartache of those trapped in their sin yet doesn't turn away. You remain available so that all who will turn to You may do so at any moment. You don't allow sympathy to compromise who You are, but You remain steadfast in the integrity of Your truth, so whoever wants to may experience true, eternal life. I will wait for You too. I will not expect You to cater to my every whim, or to submit Yourself to me, my plans, or my timing. I surrender to You. I wait for You. I listen to You. I learn from You, and I obey You.

When seeds of patience take root in me—

I see Your stable integrity.

My aimless wanderings don't move You.

You wait for me to see that I must wait for You.

When I receive Your patience, I remain faithful to You.

Your Fruit of Your Self-Control

Matthew 26:51-54

And behold, one of those who were with Jesus reached and drew out his sword, and struck the slave of the high priest and cut off his ear. Then Jesus said to him, "Put your sword back into its place; for all those who take up the sword shall perish by the sword. Or do you think that I cannot appeal to My Father, and He will at once put at My disposal more than twelve legions of angels? How then will the Scriptures be fulfilled, *which say* that it must happen this way?"

Lord, even though You did nothing wrong, they came to arrest You. You could have called for twelve legions of angels to take You away from those who came to take Your life, but you didn't. You restrained Yourself because You knew this was the Father's plan, and the end result would be glorious. You could have given up on us, decided we weren't worth it, but You knew the Father's heart. He didn't care that we weren't worth it. He loved us anyway and sent You to rescue us from our sin. There are times when the Father restrains from giving us what we rightly deserve. His judgments are true. His wrath, when it surfaces, is always justified. Yet He shows mercy at times instead. Your self-control is not just a restraint from executing judgment, not something that makes You take no action, but it is an active expression of love and forgiveness. I am grateful to You for it.

Seeds of Self-Control

Luke 23:33-34

When they came to the place called The Skull, there they crucified Him and the criminals, one on the right and the other on the left. But Jesus was saying, "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing." And they cast lots, dividing up His garments among themselves.

Lord, I will nurture Your self-control in me. I harvest the seeds from Your fruit and plant them within me. It took great self-control for You to forgive those who were crucifying You. Your self-control benefited those who received forgiveness because of Your prayer. I too have benefited from Your self-control. You remained the spotless Lamb of God who was slain for my sin. Now I have the opportunity to believe in You and become a new creation in You. I turn away from evil and turn to You and Your ways instead. Your self-control brought salvation to me. I am extremely grateful and will not trample on You by continuing in sin.

With it we bless *our* Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the likeness of God; from the same mouth come *both* blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be this way. Does a fountain send out from the same opening *both* fresh and bitter *water*?

Lord, I want Your self-control to grow in me in such a way that others can easily partake of the fruit of it. I want to create an atmosphere around me, by my words, which makes it easy for others to become grateful to You for Your mercy, knowing that You are justified in Your judgement. Vengeance is not for me to give. I will yield my tongue to the Spirit of God so blessing, not curses, flow from my mouth. I will align my words with Yours. Truly I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it *at all*." And He took them in His arms and *began* blessing them, laying His hands on them.
